Dharampal (1922-2006) was a Gandhian thinker. Author. Founder General Secretary of the Indian Cooperative Union (ICU - 1950), Chairman of the National Commission for Cattle rearing (2001)

Apart from the 3 basic needs of Human being as Food, Cloth and Shelter, now 4th one is also included in our constitution as 'Right to Education'. This is because, every human being are right to learn basic education system for running their life meaningfully. The book 'The Beautiful Tree' divulge about how the education prevails in India, past and present.

Author Dharampal, wrote many books. This 'THE BEAUTIFUL TREE' reveals the truth of Indigenous Indian Education in the Eighteenth Century. Even our India ruled by British and before that it won't have any unique features in education system, as we believed because of the wrong campaign in our political system. This is because of individual land structure of areas ruled by King dynasty and their followers. After British and French invaders came with many motive, they spread their language first. As per the report, There are Brahmin students, Vaisya students, Shutra students and other communities.
